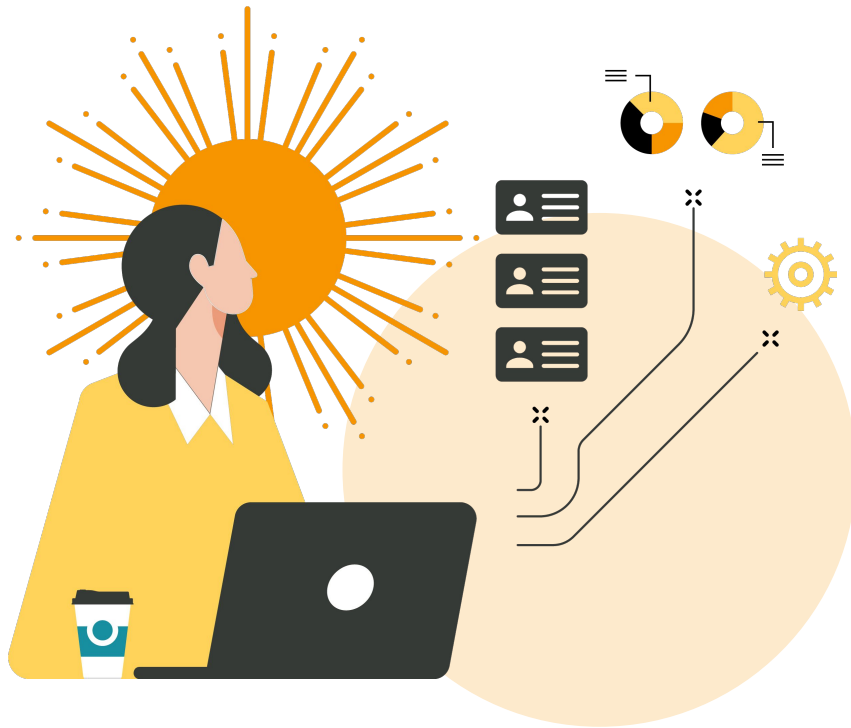

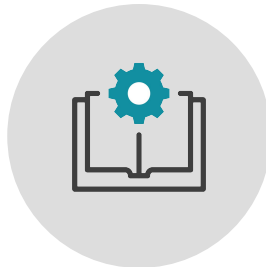

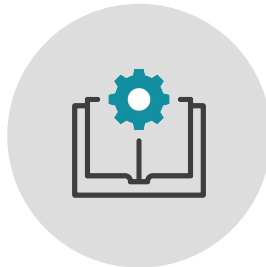

New Assessment Report – “Aggregate Assessment Results by Outcome”

Key Benefits

- Report out on program assessment results by customizing the aggregate level (Institution, College, Department, Program) level to view the data as well as the specific outcome set to view results via.
 - We are evaluating adding course and section level aggregations here in the near future
- New UI design & WCAG 2.2AA accessible
- Fills a key gap in the Outcome Assessment Summary Report & the flagged-for-retirement Program/Course Assessment Analysis Report
 - **Important note:** We will NOT retire the Program/Course Assessment Analysis until we can ensure that all prior use cases are supported. Any feedback in gaps is much appreciated!

Program Data Collections – Program Continuous Improvement “Report Builder”

Key Benefits

- Customize the which question(s) you wish to populate into a predefined 3, 4, or 5 column PDF (ZIP) report export. This is modeled after the 4-column “Nichols Report”
- Output is a pre-structured template format specifically with accessibility and ease of readability in mind
- Can also be exported into CSV with the custom chosen question(s)
- **Important Limitation Notes**
 - a. Must be a program-type data collection
 - b. Must use the Question type that pre-populates program outcomes with questions to answer within
 - c. For columns 2-5 – only the following question types can be supported at this time: SLT, TEXT, DROPDOWN, MCSA, MCMA, DOCUPLOAD

New Juried Assessment Report – “Interrater Reliability Results”

Key Benefits

- Comprehensive summary of performance across defined learning outcomes based on juried assessment results including
 - a. Aggregated mean rubric scores submitted by multiple assessors
 - b. Interrater reliability mean of final scores
 - c. Interrater reliability Kappa
 - d. Standard Deviation
- **Important** – This report will ONLY work if using Interrater Reliability in your Juried Assessment

Learning Journey – Self-Issued Evidences

A new workflow for students submitting Self Issued Evidences that may not be collected via assessment practices has been created

Key Benefits

- Fills a key gap when using Completion-based Learning Journey that still allows for evidences (assignments/artifacts) to be added for inclusion into Storied and in Comprehensive Learning Journey
- Built-in approval flow – Only evidences approved by the teaching instructor can be included available for sharing
- Align self-issued evidences to outcomes/skills, ensuring students can tell a more complete picture of their achievement at the institution
- Flexibility to decide whether you as an institution will/will not allow for this feature to be used

New UI Design for all inner pages in Outcomes Library and Standards Library

Key Benefits

- Brand new “Inner” pages within Standards Library and Outcomes Library (patterns to be expanded to other pages in coming months)
 - a. Home page – Provides key KPIs at a glance, including if the set is being used in programs/self studies
 - b. Details page – New design with a central “Save” button for the entire pages. Changes are also tracked to determine if you have/have not completed the minimum required field(s)
 - c. Outcomes/Standards Designer – New UI/UX to improve the process of managing/making updates to these sets over time.
